14.7 Appendix 7: Application process for the annual wild harvest quota of

raptors to be utilised for sport hunting activities.

Before I April, on an annual basis, Western Cape recognized falconry clubs, in co-operation with

each other, must submit to CapeNature a single wild harvest quota request per species, for

raptors to be harvested from the wild to be utilized for sport hunting activities. This request must

include the following:

a) The species being applied for and the motivation for the species;

b) The quantity of each species and the motivation for the quantity of each species;

c) The locations from where specimens of each species will be harvested; and

d) Motivation per quota request. This motivation must address existing raptors held by the clubs

for sport hunting purposes and why additional specimens are required.

CapeNature will consider each quota request based on the motivation supplied and reserves the

right to request additional information or vetting from an external independent body.
